- a) **Adopt Resolution of Continued Participation in an Instructional Support Program and Certification to the Iowa Department of Management** – Jason Schneider moved to Adopt a Resolution of Continued Participation in an Instructional Support Program and Certification to the Iowa Department of Management. - b) **Approval of Request to School Budget Review Committee for Modified Allowable Growth and Supplemental Aid for Special Education Negative Balance-** A motion was made by Jason Schneider to submit a request to the School Budget Review Committee (SBRC) for Modified Supplemental Amount and Supplemental Aid for the 2019-2020 Special Education Program deficit of \$36,252.39, or as determined by the Iowa Department of Education following DE audit review. - c) **Approval of Request to School Budget Review Committee for Modified Supplemental Amount for Open Enrollment Out not in Previous Year's Count-** A motion was made by Danette Miller, Seconded by Rachel Jacobson, to authorize the district's administration to submit a request to the School Budget Review Committee in the amount of \$55,040.00 for MSA for open enrolled out students not included in the district's previous year's certified enrollment count. The motion passed by a vote of 4 - 0. Ayes: Rachel Jacobsen, Danette Miller, Wade Gurney, and Jason Schneider. Nays: 0.
- d) **Youth Rec Basketball Discussion-**The board discussed facility usage, health and safety concerns, and scheduling for the upcoming Schleswig Youth Rec basketball season.
