- b. **Conditions of Learning Survey**-As part of the ESSA legislation, the Conditions of Learning Survey will be sent out to students in grades 3-8.
- c. **Summer Mowing**-Mr. Pardun asked the board if they would like to contract mowing services to an external provider or continue to handle those duties with existing staff. The board asked to continue handling mowing with existing staff for the upcoming summer.
- d. **Open Enrollment**-Mr. Pardun shared with the board that three open enrollment requests were turned in after the March 1st deadline and asked the board if they would consider allowing the late requests. The board reported that they would adhere to the March 1st deadline.
